Last year our students achieved 94% grade 4+, 85% grade 5+ and 42% grade 7+ (including 33 grade 9s) at GCSE and 67% A*-B at A-Level and several went on to study Mathematics at university.

Our team is made up of colleagues with a broad range of experience from trainee teachers through to those who have taught for over 25 years.
